## **SPECIAL TROPHY AWARDS**

---

**The Faith Memorial Challenge Trophy**, in memory of HC Artisan Starlight HXAs HX, offered by Cindy Mendonca, is awarded to the Bearded Collie Bitch with the highest combined score on sheep earned during the National Event(s) each year until retired, using qualifying scores from A, B, and/or C course or any combination of these courses. The trophy is a hand-painted slice of agate mounted upon wood upon which there is a place for the years and the names of the winners. This trophy is offered on a three-time win basis. For permanent possession, this trophy must be won three times at three different National Specialty Herding Event(s) by the same owner, not necessarily with the same bitch.

**The Boone Memorial Trophy**, in memory of Am Can Ch Artisan Bronze Paladin HXAs HX, offered by Ann Witte, is awarded annually to the Bearded Collie Dog with the highest combined score on sheep earned during the National Herding Event(s) each year, using qualifying scores from A, B, and/or C course or any combination of these courses. Offered on a limited lifetime basis, individual trophies will be awarded annually for a period of 25 years. The first trophy was awarded at the 2008 National Specialty, with the final trophy being awarded at the 2032 National Specialty. Individual annual trophies are small replicas of a bronze sculpture of a Bearded Collie facing off a Scottish Blackface ram mounted on a wooden base. The original sculpture, upon which each year's winner will be recorded, will be displayed at all National Specialties and remain in the permanent possession of the BCCA.

### **ADDITIONAL NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS**

No un-entered dogs (except set-out dogs) will be allowed at the trial site. **ABSOLUTELY NO PUPPIES UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE ALLOW ED ON THE PROPERTY.**

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR OTHERWISE RESTRICTED EXCEPT WHEN WORKING STOCK. Under NO circumstance will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Any dogs aggressive to persons or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the American Kennel Club *HERDING REGULATIONS*).

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED. Please bring your own chairs, shade, etc. Water and soda will be available for sale. All American Kennel Club rules regarding conduct will be strictly enforced.

OWNERS OR THEIR AGENTS are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) and at test/trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. NO CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS WITHOUT THE AGREEMENT AND RULES ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.

ENTRIES FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent (unless replaced by an Alternate), disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the test/trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall be eligible and will run at the end of the class in tests and in catalog order as listed in the class in trials. Notify the Test Secretary if your bitch is in season. (See Chapter 1, Section 3 of the American Kennel Club *Herding Regulations*).
